



Investors

- No jurisdictions blacklisted
- Widely distributed or privately placed
- Invest direct or via other vehicles set up in a variety of jurisdictions including the EU, US, Cayman, BVI depending on needs
- No withholding taxes
- Attractive carried interest arrangements

Investment Vehicle

- Regulated and non-regulated options
- Vehicle can be funded by debt or equity
- Vehicle can be open or closed ended
- ► No leverage restrictions
 - No asset restrictions
 - Minimal or no tax leakage
 - VAT recoverability on management fees

- Favoured as long-term solution. Capable of being authorised by the Central Bank of Ireland (CBI) within 24 hours, 2-3 months to establish. Interim solutions available.
- Regulated tax exempt entity, entitled to tax treaty benefits

Irish S110 Company

- Quick and easy to get to market.
- Efficient cost of set up.
- ► S110 Company is unregulated
- ► S110 regime potentially alleviates any taxable income for portfolio companies on the acquisition of distressed debt
- Entitled to tax treaty benefits
- Resident for purposes of US/IRL treaty

Irish Trade Company

- ► TradeCo is unregulated
- ► Headline Corporation tax rate applies
- Quick and easy establish
- Efficient cost of set up

Partnership

Irish 1907 LP

- Can be established in 2-5 days
- Irish LP is tax transparent from an Irish tax perspective, income therefore flows directly through to investors
- ▶ Up to 50 investors

Investment Limited Partnership (ILP)

- Irish ILP is a regulated tax exempt entity, entitled to tax treaty benefits
- Resident for purposes of US/IRL treaty
- Clear regulatory regime
- Capable of being authorised by CBI within 24 hours, 2-3 months to establish Interim solutions available


